NATIONAL NIGHTMARE

Former President Barack Obama has called President Donald Trump's coronavirus response a "chaotic disaster". He stopped short of calling his successor a "national disaster". After Trump's mediocre allegation that he had been taking hydroxychloroquine for more than a week and "I'm still here. That's why he has never shown any sorrow for the dead and empathy for tens of millions of fearful seniors at risk.

It is no secret that Trump's only thing in mind is his re-election bid. That's why he has not only his signature on the stimulus check but also a letter sent separately to attract the beneficiaries' attention.

He understands that the COVID-19 and its consequential economic and social lock-down will dump all his campaign efforts. He has therefore promised off and on some dates when the pandemic would reach the "peak", only to see his death targets being surpassed easily and quickly, from 60,000 to 75,000 to 90,000, and now near 100,000.
